## **General Provisions of the Jewish Community of Vienna**

The applicant is allowed to publish archival documents of the Jewish Community of Vienna under the following conditions:

- The applicant is obligated to respect the Archive's copyright and to protect the personal rights of all individuals as well as of all interests of third parties. Furthermore, the applicant has to comply with the legal provisions concerning data protection and civil status in the current version.
- According to the Austrian law on data protection personal data such as names of persons, addresses or similar personal information enabling the identification of persons that need to be protected may not be published; anonymization is legally required by the data protection.

(Basic rules: the individual person was born 110 years ago or is verifiably dead; the applicant owns a signed permission by a family member concerning the publication of a person's name or individual data).

- The applicant is obligated to preserve copies, images or reproductions of the archival material safe and secure from the access by unauthorized persons.
- In case of infringement of copyright and / or of personal rights the applicant is personally liable for all kind of claims.
- The applicant is obligated to indemnify the Archive of the Jewish Community of Vienna and hold the Archive harmless from any claims by third parties which derive from the use of the publication.
- The applicant is obligated to mention the "Archive of the Jewish Community of Vienna" as the owner of the archival material. All used archival documents of the Jewish Community of Vienna must be cited correctly by using the appropriate signature.
- The applicant is obligated to hand over at least two copies of each released publication free of charge to the Archive of the Jewish Community of Vienna.
- The permission of use concerning the archival documents of the Archive of the Jewish Community of Vienna is only valid for the above mentioned purpose. A transfer of the archival material to unauthorized third persons is not permitted. Any commercial use of the archival holdings is forbidden.

Film shots of the Archive made by the applicant must be authorized by the Jewish Community of Vienna.

The applicant agrees with his / her signature that he / she is obligated to abide by the "General Provisions of the Jewish Community of Vienna".
